Who Can Attend

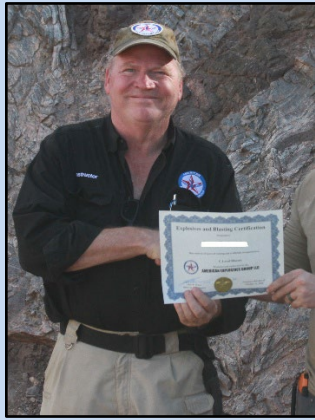

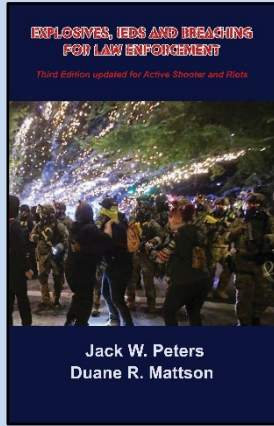

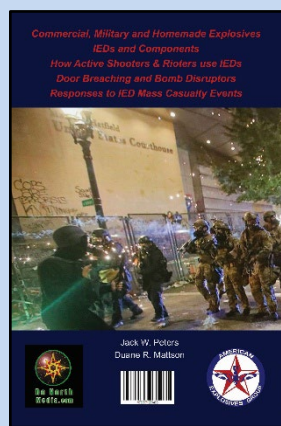
