Crushing Boulders

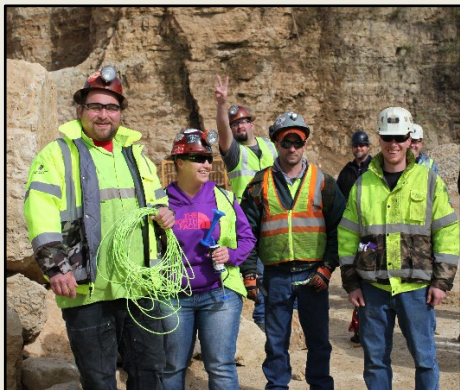
Splitting Logs

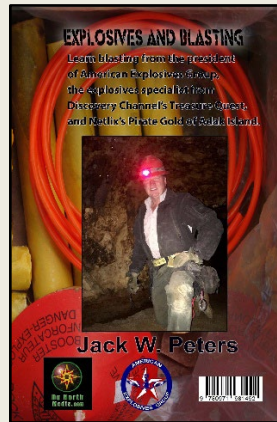
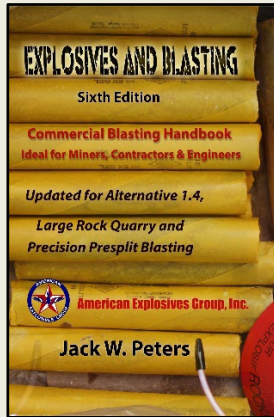
